For those that didn't attend, Samantha Gash is a World Vision Ambassador and is currently preparing for a near 4000 kilometre run across India. Samantha's 'why' for this adventure is simple. In India today, 4% of children never start school, 58% don't complete primary school, and 90% fail to finish high school.

Combined with the fact that 67.7 million of India's youths are living on less than one dollar a day, it is clear that the barriers to accessing education are highly complex.

Children being able to access education and make a better life for themselves is something very close to the heart of Business Benchmark Group team. And so we have decided to help Samantha in her quest by raising funds to cover certain aspects of the project costs that are not covered by World Vision.

As those who attended the morning will know, Samantha's personal safety whilst embarking on this run is of paramount importance and therefore we have decided to raise money to help cover some of the costs of her security team, as without this support the project doesn't happen.
